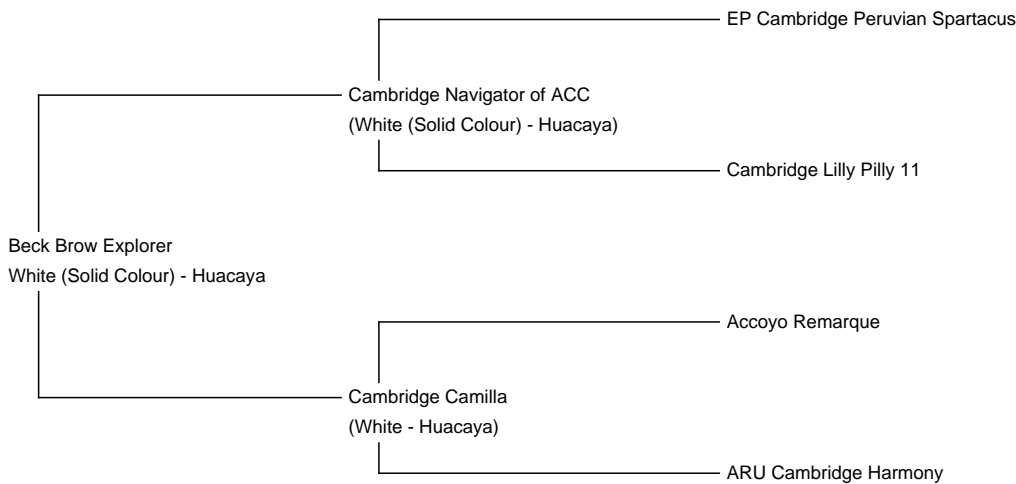

### Description:

Beck Brow Explorer has made quite a name for himself on the British alpaca show circuit, taking three supreme championships and many broad ribbons. Following in his footsteps are his progeny, who have excelled in the show ring. Explorer really is a prepotent male, stamping his mark across so many different females. Producing champion after champion at the highest level.

Explorer is sired by Cambridge Navigator of ACC, the undefeated supreme champion of the UK 2009 show season (who was sold in 2010 for £75,000). Adding to Explorer's impressive pedigree is Accoyo Remarque (Grandsire on his dam's side) arguably one of the founding super sires of the British alpaca industry, and now sadly deceased. These really are the genetics that breed champions!

Explorer is beautifully conformed, with great substance of bone and a perfect head type. He carries an extremely heavy cutting fleece, growing above average length. He displays an advanced crimp style from the top of his head, right down his legs, and under his belly. Explorer has a soft handling, bright and dense fleece with minimal guard hair, this male really does have it all.
