Description:

We were absolutely delighted when the multi-champion Stud Male, Alpaca Farm Imara joined us at Fangdale Alpacas in 2022. He is a stand out male with an exceptionally dense and fine brown fleece which has a soft handle and uniformity of micron that extends throughout his fleece to the extremities. He is conformationally correct with a good substance of bone. Imara has an impressive pedigree behind him that draws on both Snowmass and Australian genetics. His Sire is the BAS National Supreme Champion (2015), Popham Havengore and his Dam is Alpaca Farm Buttons, herself a multi-champion, who has also joined us at Fangdale Alpacas. Imara's dam, Buttons has impressed with incredible longevity of fineness as well as uniformity over the years. Her 10th Fleece was tested in 2021 at 20.5 microns with an SD of 3.8 (AAFT). Imara has an impressive Show record being awarded 1st junior brown male at the BAS 2019 National Championships and then Champion Brown Male at the NWAG Championships and the Midlands Championships in

2020 before the COVID Pandemic curtailed his show career. He is now a proven, working stud male who has consistently produced colour including over two white females.
